This MoU signifies a renewed commitment to a long-standing cooperation. The first formal partnership between REHVA and Eurovent dates back to 1999, with improvements made in 2006 and again in 2015. The Eurovent Board Member Mikael Börjesson stated: "Our renewed partnership with REHVA underscores our shared mission to create a sustainable and healthy indoor environment for all.
